

DECLARATION OF DOUGLAS M. MCKENNEY
PURSUANT TO 28 U.S.C. § 1746

I, Douglas M. McKenney, hereby declare as follows:

1. My name is Douglas M. McKenney. I am an investigator with the Federal Trade Commission ("FTC"). I have been employed by the FTC for approximately three years. In the course of my employment, I was asked to participate in an investigation of Spear Systems, Inc. ("Spear"), Bruce Parker, Lisa Kimsey, and Xavier Ratelle doing business as eHealthyLife.com.


2. On October 18, 2007, using a computer located at the FTC's Chicago office, I accessed the Web site at www.ehealthylife.com. The Web site appeared to be identical to the version advertising HoodiaLife and HGHLife that I attached as Attachment U to the declaration that I provided to the Court in support of the FTC's Motion for a Temporary Restraining Order. A true and correct copy of the Web site printouts of the ehealthylife.com Web site from October 18, 2007 is attached hereto as **McKenney Attachment A**.

3. On October 18, 2007, I also accessed the Web sites located at www.ehghlife.com, www.ehghlife.net, www.ehoodialife.com and www.purevie.com. Each of these Web sites redirected me to www.ehealthylife.com.

4. On October 17, 2007, I conducted an Internet search using the Google search engine for the fax number "(514) 385-3292." The initial search result was to a Web site at www.ratelle.ca. The ratelle.ca Web site was entitled "Ratelle & Associates" and listed its address as "8552 St-Denis, Montreal, Quebec H2P 2H2." A true and correct copy of the Web site printout of the ratelle.ca Web site is attached as **McKenney Attachment B**.
