Proof of service of summons and complaint on defendants

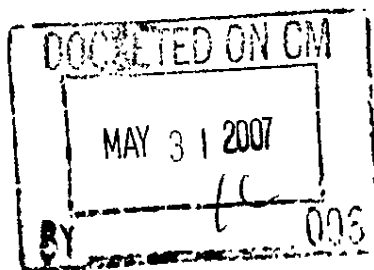
Answer by defendants
